| Mathematics discrepancy | Student may use calculator and formula reference sheets on assignments; extended time |
| Behavior Issues | Rules/safety guidelines posted on every wall of welding department; preferential seating; positive reinforcement by staff; allow use of earphones when use is not a safety or instructional issue |
| ADHD | Directions repeated often; modify time on tasks; positive reinforcement by staff; allow use of earphones when use is not a safety or instructional issue |
| Emotional Issues | Quiet room available if frustrated or upset; positive reinforcement by staff; allow use of earphones when use is not a safety or instructional issue |
| Hearing discrepancy | Copy of lecture notes will be made available; instructor will use microphone |
| English Learner Status | Tests may be given in separate room with the assistance of an interpreter; extended time |
| Spelling/Grammar Usage Issues | All students may use dictionaries on any assignment; Proofreading/tutoring available from counselor and Career Coach |
| Time issues | Tests may be taken in 2 sessions; extended time |
| Lack of basic clothing, fees, and supplies | Student will have an additional set of approved PPE (including footwear) available in the welding lab; Course fees will be waived when financial aid is documented according to LEA rules; Supply of non-perishable snacks and HBA will be available via the counselor's office |
